Who are we?

Peace at Home Advocacy Center is a community-based private non-profit agency serving Douglas County since 1978. Peace at Home focuses exclusively on providing comprehensive services to survivors of family violence, sexual assault, dating violence, stalking, and human trafficking. The organization is the only victim services agency in the county that provides crisis intervention services through a 24-hour Hotline, supported by certified advocates.

To meet the needs of our community we have six teams with trained volunteer and paid advocates.

1. **Emergency Services.** 24/7 Crisis Line, safety planning, peer counseling, resources and referrals, and urgent transportation.
2. **Sexual Assault Response Services.** Support during the forensic medical exam, law enforcement interview, and resources.
3. **Legal Advocacy.** Assistance filing protective orders and support during the court hearing.
4. **Shelter Services.** Short-term shelter units, pet friendly, clothing and food assistance, peer support, and transportation.
5. **Transitional Housing.** Affordable housing units.
6. **Community Outreach & Education.** This team of advocates provides training and consultation for providers. Education for all ages in the community and hosts events.
